This matter came before the Court on the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Approving a Stipulation to Three-Month Suspension pursuant to ELC 9.1(c)(2), entered into by Raj Bains, his counsel and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on March 24, 2016. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation and determined by a majority that an order approving the stipulation to suspension should be entered. Now, therefore, it is

ORDERED:

Raj Bains is suspended from the practice of law for three months. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is 7 days from the date of this order. Mr. Bains shall comply with the terms of the stipulation including payment of attorney fees and administrative costs of \$500 in accordance with ELC 13.9(i).
